In terms of sections 5(2)(d) and 6(2)(b) of the CBE Act, 2000, the CBE hereby invites nominations for members of the public to be appointed for its third term of office.

The term of office of members will be four years. The council meets at least four times per year and the appointed person may be required to serve in the subcommittees of the council.

Nominees must be persons with leadership qualities. Preference will be given to persons with either legal, finance, corporate governance or human-resource experience to contribute to the strategic direction of the CBE in the interest of the built environment and the public whom they represent.

Nominations should be made on the Nomination Form provided on the CBE website or on request from the e-mail address below. Race, gender and geographical representivity will be taken into account at the evaluation of the nominations. Nominators and nominees should ensure that they are conversant with the CBE Act, 2000, especially Section 8(1)-(4) defining the disqualification requirements.

Please note that failure to comply with the above requirements, may result in the disqualification of the nomination.
